We are hoping to cut down on too many emails and texts using a cost effective method and updating the google calendar on the website so you are able to sync this with your phone.

Website and X (Twitter)

Again, in response to the Parent survey, we are trying to showcase every class and their learning/ achievements in order to show how exceptional our pupils and their achievements are! Each class will be tweeting at least once per week and this will also show on our website blog and we would love it if you would support us by visiting our website, liking, sharing and commenting on our posts.

We are promoting all things good about Hillcrest and what makes our school special and I hope you will share in our successes. In school we are talking to the children about their learning and are currently undertaking a pupil survey.

Sports Day

All parents are invited to our sports days- if in a morning, parents can stay after drop off and find their seats ready for the action and parents would need to enter school through the main gate for the afternoon. We will be on the large field between the 2 buildings. As usual Mr Smith will be leading the proceedings and staff will be supporting the children in their classes. If we could ask that you leave your child to sit with their classes and enjoy the action from the parent designated areas, they will need their water bottles, sun hats etc with them in the morning so they are fully prepared and ready to start. Supporting children and families- Online Safety

We would like to remind parents of our online safety workshop- Cybersavvy- on Tuesday 18th June via Zoom for those interested in finding out more ways to keep children safe online led by the Anti- Bullying Alliance. In addition; our local PSCO Whaley is coming into school to deliver a presentation to our KS2 children around keeping safe online. If any parents (in other year groups) would like to join us to hear the messages and ask any questions of our PCSO at the end of the meeting you are more than welcome to attend. The presentation will be at 9am in the hall but you are welcome to sign in and wait in the main hall after the bell rings at 8:45am and the children come into school.

Summer Fayre

We are really looking forwards to our Summer Fayre this year and hope that by hosting it during our school day we can offer even more activities than usual! Staff and children will be setting up stalls and activities during lunchtime and we'd ask you to be patient with us as we set up, gates will open after registration and you may collect your child from their classroom. All children collected at 1:15pm will have their belongings with them and they will be dismissed into your care meaning you can leave with them when you are ready after going to the summer fayre.



This includes our Y5 and Y6 pupils who normally walk home at the end of the day- they will need to be collected to attend the fayre.

Any child whose parent cannot collect them at 1:15pm or are not being collected by another family member/ designated adult will remain in school in the KS2 main hall (and can be collected from the main school office) and will be able to attend the fayre with school staff at some point during the afternoon.

Please inform school (class teacher) if your child is being collected by a different adult to normal to go around the fayre with so we know to release them and that your child knows who is collecting them too. This is for Safeguarding reasons.

We have 2 Libraries AND they are OPEN!

Since half term we have been opening our new and improved libraries **every Tuesday after school between 3:15** - **3:45.** Children may choose a book to sign out of the library to enjoy at home or you may just want to sit and read together whilst visiting. Please enter school via the Y1 door for both libraries.

The FS/KS1 library is now located on the lower school corridor (go through the archway) and the KS2 'Harry Potter' library is situated in the room next to Y1. We are so lucky as one of our PTA members has offered to volunteer in our library during this time to check in/ out books.
