Class 7 Speech and Language Integrated Resource Expectations

In Class 7 we regularly discuss the expectations which the children are expected to meet in the classroom and when moving around school.

The children know the school rules:

These are displayed within our classroom and regularly discussed and recognised.

Rewards and Recognitions

In Class 7, children work hard to earn Dojos in recognition of demonstrating our school values as well as trying hard with their speech and language targets or just trying their best.

Dojos will also be awarded for reading at least four times per week. Children enjoy earning stickers from the adults in class and love sharing their hard work with Mrs Rayner to gain a headteachers award.

Children also have the chance every week to earn the Star of the Week, Lunchtime Lovely and Sporting Superstar awards. The child with the most Dojos for the week will receive a raffle ticket, to be entered into Mrs Rayner's half termly prize draw to win a book.



PE Kits

We currently have PE all Wednesday afternoon and children should have their kit in school on this day. Once the PE sessions for the week have taken place the PE kit can be taken home to be washed. Please ensure your child has both an indoor and outdoor kit, which has been fully labelled with your child's name.

Water Bottles and Snacks

Children need to bring their own water bottle in to school every day. It is important that the children are hydrated throughout the day to ensure that they are alert and able to participate effectively in lessons. Bottles are accessible throughout the day and should only be filled with water. If your child brings their own snack in, please ensure it is a healthy snack and doesn't contain any nuts.

Equipment

Every child in Class 7 should bring in their learning wallet every day, which should contain their phonics book, colour banded reading books and their Learning Log. Recommended reading books only need to be brought in when they are swapped on a Friday. Learning Logs will be checked weekly to ensure children are regularly reading at home.

Home Learning

In class 7 the children will receive weekly speech and language homework set by the speech and language therapists. It is so important that children complete this homework with an adult so their speech and language targets are being reinforced at home. Reading should be recorded in the Learning Log and a list of suggested websites to support your child's learning can be found in the log along with login details. You will also find extra activities that your child can do at home to reinforce their learning. Your support in learning at home is crucial and this could be reading together, playing games, telling the time, counting and asking them to tell you about something new they have learned each day.

We have high expectations of the children in class and will continue to reward them for showing the school values and aspiring to do the best that they can!
