

Year 2 Expectations

In Class 2, we have collaborated as a team to create our class charter which incorporates all our school values and ways we think we can be ready respectful and safe in school. All the children, as well as the teaching team have signed this to clearly show that we agree to follow these expectations.

School Uniform

PE Kits

It is expected that the children bring their PE kit to school at the start of the week. They can then take this home on Monday (after our PE lessons) or at the end of the week to be washed. But children must ensure they have a PE kit in school as gymnastics can be tricky in school uniform.

Water Bottles

The children need to bring their own water bottle into school every day. This is important to ensure they can participate in the learning effectively by being hydrated throughout the day.



Home Learning

Children have TT Rockstars log ins and Maths Passports to practice at home so they can work on their times tables. They also have Spelling Shed log in details so that they can practice the same spellings they are working on at school at home. Encouraging your child to do this will really help them! I also tend to send additional activities home now and again. These are not compulsory- but again will help your child cement their learning.

Each week children will be given a new reading book on a Thursday and a new recommended read. The reading book is for the children to read to their grown ups at home and the recommended read is for you to read to or with your child as these texts are not banded at their level but are to encourage a love of learning.
